
It has been ten years since the shipwreck of 3 October 2013, off the coasts of Lampedusa. The "A Europe of Rights" event aims to inform people on what has happened so far, over these past ten years, which have seen the death of over 27,000 people in the attempt of crossing the Mediterranean Sea. On the occasion of the 10th anniversary of the Day of Remembrance and Reception, "A Europe of Rights" is designed to promote learning opportunities among the young Italian and European generations, in a perspective of intercultural education, and contribute to developing a culture of solidarity, reception, and dialogue, based on full and conscious respect for human rights. The event includes workshops and round tables, as well as the testimonies of those who survived the shipwrecks, those involved in rescue at sea operations, the relatives of those who lost their lives in the Mediterranean Sea, those who work to give a name to the victims, and the people involved in reception procedures.
